**Mercer County Narcotics Task Force Seizes
Heroin, Cash and a Handgun**

TRENTON -- Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. and Trenton Police Director Ernest Parrey reported that the Mercer County Narcotics Task Force concluded an investigation on Thursday with one arrest, and the seizure of heroin, cash and a handgun.

Bocchini stated that at approximately 12:45 p.m. on August 7, officers with the prosecutor's office, the county sheriff's office, New Jersey State Police, and the Hamilton, Lawrence, Robbinsville and Trenton police, under the command of Lt. Mike Novembre, executed a search warrant at 15 Eastburn Avenue in Trenton. Abdul Hakeem Frazier was located on the couch with a fully loaded .380 caliber semiautomatic handgun hanging around his neck with a shoelace. Frazier was secured without incident.

A search of Frazier's residence revealed 372 decks of heroin in the living room and \$1,351 in a bedroom. Fifty dollars was discovered during a search of Frazier's BMW. Novembre said the estimated street value of the heroin is \$3,720.

Frazier, 21, is charged with possession of a controlled dangerous substance, possession with the intent to distribute, possession with the intent to distribute within 500 feet of a park, possession of a firearm with committing a narcotics offense and certain persons not to possess a weapon. He is being held on \$100,000 cash bail.

Despite having been charged, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
