TRENTON MAN ARRESTED FOR MURDER

Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. and Trenton Police Director Ernest Parrey reported the arrest of a Trenton man for the July 12, 2014 murder of 20-year-old Enrico Smalley Jr.

Shaheed Brown (DOB 2.2.84), of South Broad Street, Trenton, is charged with murder, possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, unlawful possession of a weapon and certain persons not to possess a weapon.

The charges are the result of a Mercer County Homicide Task Force investigation. At approximately 1:21 a.m. on July 12, Trenton police responded to a report of shots fired at the corner of Poplar Street and North Clinton Avenue. Upon arrival, officers located the victim, later identified as Smalley, laying on the ground in front of LaGuira Bar suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Smalley was transported to Capital Health Regional Medical Center where he was pronounced dead a short time later.

Brown was arrested Saturday evening in Newark, NJ, by Newark police. He was transported back to Trenton by members of the Mercer County Homicide Task Force and is being held on \$1 million cash or bond bail.

Despite having been charged, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
