**Two Trenton Men Indicted for the Murder
of Chevin Burgess**

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a six-count indictment last week charging two Trenton men with the January 2014 death of 22-year-old Chevin Burgess, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. reported.

Joeryan Foreman, age 20, of South Broad Street, and Calier Samad, age 27, of Hart Avenue, were each indicted on counts of first-degree felony murder, first-degree robbery, second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, second-degree unlawful possession of a weapon and second-degree aggravated arson. Samad was additionally charged with one count of first-degree murder.

An investigation by the Mercer County Homicide Task Force revealed that a robbery scheme by the defendants resulted in Burgess being shot in the head by Samad on January 4, 2014, at approximately 7 p.m., causing his death. The victim's body was then driven to the side of 104 Hart Avenue in Trenton, where the vehicle was doused with gasoline and set on fire.

Foreman remains in jail in lieu of \$600,000 bail. Samad remains in jail in lieu of \$1 million bail.

Senior Assistant Prosecutor James Scott presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
