Maryland Man Indicted for Attempted Murder

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury recently returned an indictment charging a Maryland man with attempting to murder his ex-girlfriend in a Hamilton Subway restaurant in December 2014, Acting Mercer County Prosecutor Angelo J. Onofri reported.

Yoon S. Choi, age 48, of Silver Spring, Md., is charged with first-degree attempted murder, third-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and fourth-degree unlawful possession of a weapon.

At approximately 1 p.m. on December 9, 2014, Choi repeatedly stabbed the woman in the neck while at the Subway restaurant on Sunnybrae Boulevard. The 44-year-old woman from Connecticut suffered extensive blood loss, nerve damage, and was forced to undergo multiple surgeries to repair her esophagus.

Choi remains in the Mercer County Correction Center in lieu of \$750,000 bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Stacey Geurds, chief of the Domestic Violence Unit, presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
