**TRENTON MAN ARRESTED IN FLORIDA
FOR 2014 MURDER**

TRENTON – Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. and Trenton Police Director Ernest Parrey reported the arrest of a Trenton man for the December 13, 2014 murder of Patrick Walker.

Anthony L. Concepcion (DOB 1.2.92) of Bridge Street, Trenton, is charged with murder, possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and unlawful possession of a weapon.

The charges are the result of a Mercer County Homicide Task Force investigation. At approximately 1:59 a.m. on December 13, police responded to the corner of North Clinton Avenue and Poplar Street on a report of a shooting in progress. Upon arrival, officers located Walker, age 39, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported to Capital Health Regional Medical Center where he was pronounced dead shortly thereafter.

The U.S. Marshals NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force developed leads on Concepcion's whereabouts and forwarded that information to its counterpart in Florida. Concepcion was arrested on Friday, January 9, 2015, in a hotel in Altamont Springs, Florida, by the U.S. Marshals Florida Regional Fugitive Task Force.

Bail was set at \$500,000 cash or bond. Concepcion is being held at the Seminole County Jail pending extradition proceedings.

Despite having been charged, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
