Trenton Man Indicted for Murder

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a three-count indictment Wednesday charging a Trenton man with the shooting death of 39-year-old Patrick Walker, Acting Mercer County Prosecutor Angelo J. Onofri reported.

Anthony Concepcion (DOB 1.2.92), of Bridge Street, was indicted on one count of first-degree murder, one count of second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and one count of second-degree unlawful possession of a weapon.

The charges are the result of a Mercer County Homicide Task Force investigation. At approximately 1:59 a.m. on December 13, 2014, police responded to the corner of North Clinton Avenue and Poplar Street on a report of a shooting in progress. Upon arrival, officers located Walker suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported to Capital Health Regional Medical Center where he was pronounced dead shortly thereafter.

The U.S. Marshals NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force developed leads on Concepcion's whereabouts and forwarded that information to its counterpart in Florida. Concepcion was arrested on Friday, January 9, 2015, in a hotel in Altamont Springs, Florida, by the U.S. Marshals Florida Regional Fugitive Task Force.

Concepcion remains in the Mercer County Correction Center in lieu of \$750,000 bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Michelle Gasparian presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
