Two Trenton Men Indicted for Murder

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a seven-count indictment on Wednesday charging two Trenton men with the January 2013 shooting death of 35-year-old Andre Corbett, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. announced.

Keith Wells-Holmes, 21, and Zihqwan Clemens, 23, were each indicted on one count of murder, one count of second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and one count of second-degree unlawful possession of a handgun. Clemens was additionally indicted on four narcotics charges for heroin that was seized from his residence during the course of the murder investigation.

Corbett was shot several times by Wells-Holmes while standing outside an apartment complex near the corner of Hoffman Avenue and Oakland Street on January 21, 2013. Clemens acted as a getaway driver.

Both Wells-Holmes and Clemens remain in jail in lieu of \$1 million bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Thomas Meidt presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
