**Fugitive Task Force Arrests Trenton Man with Gun and Drugs**

**TRENTON** -- Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. announced that last Wednesday, members of the prosecutor's office and the U.S. Marshals NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force arrested **Donelle Boldt** of Trenton.

At approximately 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 17, Mercer County Prosecutor's Detective Dean McCleese and members of the U.S. Marshals NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force proceeded to 110 Hancock Street, Trenton, to arrest Boldt on a warrant out of Lawrence Township. Upon their arrival, a Smith & Wesson .38 caliber revolver was found in plain view. Officers then obtained and executed a search warrant, and found Boldt in possession of suspected marijuana, cocaine, three decks of heroin, 12 Percocet pills and packaging paraphernalia.

Boldt, 32, is charged with multiple counts of possession of a controlled dangerous substance, possession with the intent to distribute, possession with the intent to distribute within 1,000 feet of a school, possession with the intent to distribute within 500 feet of a park and possession of a weapon while committing a narcotics offences. He is being held in the Mercer County Correction Center. Bail was set at \$150,000 on the new charges.

Despite having been charged, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
