On May 2, 2011, at approximately 1830 hours, Ewing Patrol Units were detailed to a residence in the first block of Woodland Avenue on the report of an unresponsive male. Upon their arrival and the arrival of medical personnel, the victim was pronounced dead at the scene. The scene was immediately secured and the Ewing Police Department Detective Bureau along with the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office Homicide Unit were notified and responded to the scene to begin their investigation.

The victim is a 55-year-old, white male whose name is being withheld at this time pending the notification of his next of kin.

The victim's body was removed from the scene by the Mercer County Medical Examiner's Office and is scheduled for an autopsy on Wednesday, May 4, to determine the cause of death.

The victim's body had visible signs of trauma and the circumstances surrounding the death are being investigated as a homicide.

The Ewing Police Department Crime Scene Unit is processing the scene with assistance from the New Jersey State Police.
