## **Trenton Man Indicted for Murder**

**TRENTON** – A Mercer County grand jury returned an indictment on Friday charging a Trenton man with the September 2013 stabbing death of his housemate, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. reported.

Fredy Gonzalez, 21, was indicted on counts of first-degree murder, third-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and fourth-degree unlawful possession of a weapon.

Just before 12:30 a.m. on September 29, 2013, Trenton police were called to a house in the 800 block of South Clinton Ave. Upon their arrival, they found residents restraining Gonzalez until police arrived. The victim, 24-year-old Raul Cruz, was stabbed in the chest with a large kitchen knife.

Gonzalez remains in jail in lieu of \$1 million bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Thomas Meidt, chief of the Trial Section, presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
