Two Trenton Men Indicted for the Murder of Jahmir Hall

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a four-count indictment last week charging two Trenton men with the April 2014 shooting death of Jahmir Hall, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. reported.

Daniel McCargo, age 28, of Walnut Avenue, and Curtis Grier, age 28, of Ardmore Avenue, were each indicted on counts of first-degree murder, second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and second-degree unlawful possession of a weapon. McCargo was additionally charged with one count of second-degree certain persons not to possess a firearm.

At approximately 12:28 a.m. on Saturday, April 19, Trenton police officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Quinton Avenue on a report of shots fired. Officers located the victim, 24-year-old Hall of Trenton, lying partially under a pickup truck. Hall was transported to St. Francis Medical Center where he was pronounced dead at 1:01 a.m. An investigation by the Mercer County Homicide Task Force determined that two actors were involved and fled the scene in a black Mercedes Benz. Approximately 40 minutes later, McCargo and Grier were spotted in the same type of vehicle.

McCargo remains in the Mercer County Correction Center in lieu of \$300,000 full cash bail. Grier is free on \$300,000 bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Brian McCauley presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
