**Robbinsville Township Police Sergeant Admitted into  
Pretrial Intervention Program**

**TRENTON** – A Robbinsville Township police sergeant was admitted today into a pretrial intervention program that requires him to forfeit all current and future government employment.

This morning, Mark Lee, 45, entered a plea of not guilty to a five-count accusation before Mercer County Superior Court Judge Gerald J. Council. The accusation charges him with endangering the welfare of a child, official misconduct and three counts of aggravated assault for an incident that occurred on September 17, 2012, at Project Freedom in Robbinsville.

Lee's participation in the PTI program also requires his continued medical and psychiatric treatment, and no contact with any victims in the case. Lee will be under supervision for a three year-period.

Lee's bail was reduced on October 25, 2012, after preliminary reports from a court-ordered psychiatric evaluation indicated he was suffering from a neurological disorder.
