CHARGES FILED IN 2012 HOMICIDE

Acting Mercer County Prosecutor Angelo J. Onofri and Ewing Police Chief John Stemler III reported that charges have been filed in the September 2012 shooting death of 22-year-old Jared Littlejohn.

Markquice Thomas AKA Tank (DOB 2.24.86), of Trenton, NJ, is charged with murder, two counts of felony murder, kidnapping, robbery, possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, unlawful possession of a weapon and certain persons not to possess a weapon.

On September 27, 2012, at approximately 3 p.m., Littlejohn was abducted from the parking lot of a Ewing Township supermarket in his Chevrolet Impala. Littlejohn was driven a short distance to an apartment complex on Parkside Avenue, where he was assaulted and shot in the head.

The charges are the result of an investigation by the Mercer County Homicide Task Force and the Ewing police. Complaints were signed on March 19, 2015, charging Thomas with Littlejohn's murder. Thomas was served his complaints on March 20, 2015, at the Mercer County Correction Center. Bail on the homicide was set at \$1 million cash only. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant Prosecutor Michelle Gasparian.

Despite having been charged, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
