Trenton Man Indicted for Ex-Girlfriend's Murder

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a six-count indictment on Friday charging a Trenton man with the November 2012 shooting death of his ex-girlfriend, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. announced.

William Marshall, 46, of North Warren Street, was indicted on counts of murder, second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, second-degree unlawful possession of a handgun, second-degree certain persons not to possess a firearm, and two counts of third-degree aggravated assault.

On November 16, 2012, Marshall used his vehicle to ram the car of his 42-year-old ex-girlfriend, Ruschell Fireall, as she was driving with her mother on Pennington Road attempting to get away from him. After she was run off of the road and got out of the car, Marshall shot her multiple times. He fled the state and was captured in Atlanta, Georgia, about 10 days later.

Marshall remains in jail in lieu of \$1 million bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Michelle Gasparian presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
