As part of Child Abuse Prevention Month of April, we call on Mercer County community members to take initiative to prevent child sexual abuse for the children of Mercer County. This workshop includes a showing of an 18-minute video about Jenna's story of the abuse she faced, presented by Michael Weinstein from the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention team at AAP/NJ and Daisy Freer, Ph.D, FTSS Clinical Coordinator.

Participants will learn about the:

- Behavior signs in children or teens that indicate sexual abuse and how to respond;
- Reasons that make it difficult for victims of child sexual abuse to tell; and
- How to respond if we see behavior signs in an adult that indicate they might pose a risk to children and teens

In addition, Beverly Regan, MDT Coordinator, along with an Assistant Prosecutor and Detective from the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office-Special Victim's Unit will be speaking about reporting child physical and sexual abuse and the prosecution of those cases.
