**Trenton Man Indicted for the Murder
of Enrico Smalley Jr.**

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a four-count indictment last week charging a Trenton man with the July 2014 shooting death of Enrico Smalley Jr., Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. reported.

Shaheed Brown, age 30, of South Broad Street, was indicted on one count each of first-degree murder, second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, second-degree unlawful possession of a weapon and second-degree certain persons not to possess a firearm.

Trenton police were called to the area of Poplar Street and North Clinton Avenue in Trenton at approximately 1:21 a.m. on July 12, 2014. Officers located the victim, 20-year-old Smalley of Ewing, lying on the ground in front of LaGuira Bar suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Smalley was transported to Capital Health Regional Medical Center where he was pronounced dead shortly thereafter.

An investigation by the Mercer County Homicide Task Force led to the charges against Brown, who was arrested in Newark in August 2014.

Brown remains in the Mercer County Correction Center in lieu of \$1 million bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Brian McCauley presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
