## **Ewing Man Indicted for Murder**

**TRENTON** – A Mercer County grand jury returned an indictment today charging a 51-year-old Ewing man with the shooting death of 24-year-old Timothy Rivella, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. announced.

Wayne Voorhees, of Sullivan Way, Ewing, was indicted on one count of first-degree murder and three counts of second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose.

On July 14, 2011, local, county and state police responded to the Versailles Apartment complex on Sullivan Way to find Rivella dead in the parking lot. He had been shot in the abdomen from a second-story window by Voorhees. Voorhees remained barricaded in his apartment for hours until the standoff ended with police entering the apartment. Voorhees was found alive inside the apartment, but suffering from a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head.

Voorhees remains in the Mercer County Correction Center in lieu of \$1 million bail.

Assistant Prosecutor James Scott presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
