Trenton Man Indicted for Murder

TRENTON – A Mercer County grand jury returned a five-count indictment last week charging a Trenton man with the shooting death of 43-year-old George Jamison of Pennington, Acting Mercer County Prosecutor Angelo J. Onofri reported.

Randy Washington (DOB 1.28.81), of Calhoun Street, was indicted on one count of first-degree murder, one count of first-degree felony murder, one count of first-degree robbery, one count of second-degree possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose and one count of second-degree unlawful possession of a handgun.

At approximately 10:20 p.m. on July 30, 2014, Trenton police officers were dispatched to 18-20 North Broad Street on a report of a man shot. Upon arrival, officers located the victim, later identified as Jamison, suffering from a single gunshot wound to the back. Jamison was transported to Capital Health Regional Medical Center where he was pronounced dead. An investigation revealed that Jamison was sitting on a bus stop bench when Washington robbed him at gunpoint. Washington was observed bicycling away from the scene toward East Hanover Street.

Following an investigation by the Mercer County Homicide Task Force, complaints were signed on November 5, 2014, charging Washington with Jamison's murder. He remains in jail on \$2.3 million bail.

Assistant Prosecutor Stacey Geurds presented the case to the grand jury.

Despite having been indicted, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
