**Trenton Water Works Employee Pleads Guilty to  
Official Misconduct**

**TRENTON** – A Trenton Water Works employee under indictment for his role in the use of Trenton Water Works resources and employees to perform private plumbing work and water service hookups while being paid by the city pleaded guilty today, Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. announced.

Robert Keith Williams, 51, of Meade Street, Trenton, pleaded guilty before Mercer County Superior Court Judge Mark J. Fleming to third-degree official misconduct.

Under the terms of the plea agreement, Williams will be sentenced to three years in state prison. He must serve 18 months before becoming eligible for parole. Williams' plea agreement also requires him to provide truthful testimony and cooperation with the state in the cases of his co-defendants. Sentencing is scheduled for March 2012.

Bocchini credited his Economic Crime Unit with the investigation leading to the guilty plea. Assistant Prosecutor James Scott, chief of the unit, represented the state.
