## **Guilty Plea in 2008 Death**

Isabel "Sissy" Livingston, 60, of Tyrell Avenue, pleaded guilty today in the 2008 stabbing death of Gaile Hall.

Livingston entered a plea of guilty to first-degree aggravated manslaughter. Under the terms of the plea agreement, Livingston will be sentenced to 10 years in state prison and must serve 85 percent of that sentence before becoming parole eligible.

Police found the 48-year-old victim lying on a porch on North Clinton Avenue at approximately 12:45 a.m. on June 22, 2008, with an apparent stab wound to the chest. She was transported to the hospital where she was pronounced dead.

Police later located Livingston at the corner of Webster Street and Colvert Alley and placed her under arrest. She remains in jail on \$250,000 bail.

The prosecutor's Homicide Unit and the Trenton Police Department conducted the investigation. Assistant Prosecutor Skylar Weissman represented the state.

Mercer County Superior Court Judge Gerald J. Council presided over the hearing. The judge scheduled sentencing for June 9.
