**Prosecutor's Office Concludes Investigation**

*Finds actions of Ewing police captain do not rise to the level of criminal conduct*

The Mercer County Prosecutor's Office announced today the conclusion of its investigation into allegations of misconduct committed by Ewing Township Police Captain David B. Morgan between September 2008 and May 2009.

In June 2009, Ewing Township Police Chief Robert A. Coulton advised Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. that Captain David B. Morgan had engaged in conduct that could be deemed criminal in nature. Consequently, an investigation was conducted by the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office Internal Affairs Unit, under the direction of Deputy First Assistant Prosecutor Doris M. Galuchie, and assisted by the Internal Affairs Unit of the Ewing Township Police Department.

The investigation consisted of interviews of more than 20 individuals, the review of numerous documents, including correspondence, e-mails, telephone records, contracts, policies and procedures, and other written materials, as well as a detailed analysis of applicable law.

Based upon this investigation, the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office has determined that the actions alleged to have been committed by Morgan do not rise to the level of criminal conduct and thus this matter will not be presented to a grand jury. The criminal investigation is now closed and our office has referred the matter back to the municipal police department so that disciplinary charges originally filed on August 24, 2009, can be pursued.
