Prosecutor's SIU Seizes Cocaine, Arrests Two Trenton Men

Mercer County Prosecutor Joseph L. Bocchini Jr. announced that a two-month investigation conducted by his Special Investigations Unit (SIU), under the command of Lt. Rich Frascella, has led to the arrest of two individuals and the seizure of \$5,000 in narcotics.

Bocchini stated that at approximately 3 p.m. Wednesday, his SIU assisted by Trenton police and the Mercer County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant at an apartment at 38 Grand Avenue in Trenton. The target of the investigation, 25-year-old Raymond McMiller, was located inside the residence and arrested along with 37-year-old Tyrone Truesdale.

A search of the dwelling revealed crack cocaine packaged for sale in McMiller's bedroom and cash totaling \$21,460 hidden in various spots. An additional stash of powder and crack cocaine was found outside under the house along with a scale.

McMiller was charged with possession of a controlled dangerous substance, possession with the intent to distribute, possession with the intent to distribute within 1000 feet of a school and possession of drug paraphernalia. He is being held at the Mercer County Correction Center in lieu of \$100,000 bail. Truesdale was charged with possession of a controlled dangerous substance and released on a summons.

Frascella stated that seized cocaine has an approximate street value of \$5,600.

Despite having been charged, every defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
